The Pennsylvania Election Integrity Grant is provided to help counties with mandates such as Act 77 and the requirement for prec canvassing and canvassing of mail/absentee ballots. The BlueCrest equipment allows for the sorting and scanning of the mail/absentee return ballots to create files that can be transferred to the Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE) system to allow for timely notifications to voters that their mail/absentee envelopes have been received. This equipment also helps the County sort envelopes down to the precinct level for processing of batches and compliance with and performance of the mandate for post-election Risk Limiting Audits (RLAs).
